RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE REVISED CITY COUNCIL POLICY CHAPTER 2.07 REGARDING THE DISPLAY OF FLAGS

City Council Policy Manual Chapter 2.07, Flag Display Policy, regulates the display of National, State, and other flags; and

The policy clearly states that the City of Stockton flagpoles located at City-owned buildings and facilities are not intended to serve as a forum for free expression of the public; and

On March 24, 2025, the Legislation and Environmental Committee reviewed and discussed revisions to the Flag Display Policy; and

The Committee forwarded a recommendation to revise the policy to allow the City Council to display commemorative flags for up to thirty (30) days; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the revisions to City Council Policy Manual 2.07, Flag Display Policy, attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take appropriate and necessary actions to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
