RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE DOWNTOWN EAST-WEST CONNECTION IMPROVEMENTS, PROJECT NO. WT22050/FEDERAL PROJECT NO. ATPL-5008(199)

On January 15, 2026, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the Downtown East-West Connection Improvements, Project No. WT22050/Federal Project No. ATPL-5008(199); and

The project will restripe the roadway to add bicycle facilities, upgrade sidewalk corners to Americans with Disabilities Act standards, install speed cushions, rectangular rapid flashing beacons, crosswalks, signal timing improvements, and new signage; and

Rapid Services, LLC dba Rapid Grading Services is the lowest responsible bidder in the amount of \$1,385,000 and its bid is regular in all respects; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the Downtown East-West Connection Improvements, Project No. WT22050/Federal Project No. ATPL-5008(199).

2. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and Rapid Services, LLC dba Rapid Grading Services, in the amount of \$1,385,000, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
