RESOLUTION APPROVING AMENDMENTS TO THE STANDARD CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO REVOCABLE PERMITS TO MODIFY THE CONDITION RELATED TO SIDEWALK CAFES AND UPDATE OUTDATED REFERENCES AND REQUIREMENTS

Ordinance No. 028-00 (Revocable Permits), and Resolution 00-0554 (Standard Conditions Applicable to Revocable Permits), adopted on November 14, 2000, recognize the use of a portion of the public sidewalk immediately adjacent to a café or restaurant business use for dining/seating area; and

For eating establishments that provide outdoor restaurants with full bar services, a City use permit and specific Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) license Type 47 (full bar service) are required; and

Business owners have requested an amendment to remove the specific license Type 47 requirement to allow sidewalk dining/seating food establishments to serve alcoholic beverages according to their current liquor license type; and

The Standard Conditions Applicable to Revocable Permits also contains references that are no longer current. The proposed amendments remove references to the Director of Public Works as the issuing authority, consistent with the Stockton Municipal Code 16.72.127, and remove references to an old Uniform Building Code (UBC) standard and update it with the current California Building Code (CBC); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the amendment to the Standard Conditions Applicable to Revocable Permits, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
