## **STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL**

## RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-26 PROJECT LIST FOR THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017 (SB1) AND SUBMITTAL OF REPORTS TO THE CALIFORNIA TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION

On April 28, 2017, the Governor signed Senate Bill 1 (SB1), known as the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017. SB1 funding provides for basic road maintenance, rehabilitation, and critical safety needs on both the State highway and local streets and road systems; and

The California Transportation Commission (CTC) is responsible for oversight of funding and/or programs created with the approval of SB1; and

SB1 provides funding for the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA) Program. The RMRA funding is part of the City's overall Gas Tax allocation; however, RMRA funds can only be expended on projects that meet eligibility criteria and have been approved by the CTC; and

The Fiscal Year (FY) 2025-26 RMRA funding allocation for the City is estimated to be \$8,403,380; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the FY 2025-26 project list for the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (SB1), in the amount of \$8,403,380, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by reference.

2. The City Council authorizes the Public Works Director or his/her designee to submit all necessary reports to the CTC related to the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (SB1).

3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
