RESOLUTION IDENTIFYING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL COMPENSATION FOR PROVIDING RESPONSE TO THE CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES (OES) INCIDENTS AWAY FROM THEIR OFFICIAL DUTY STATION OUTSIDE OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON

The City of Stockton Fire Department is a public agency located in the County of San Joaquin, State of California; and

The City of Stockton has in its employ, Fire Department response personnel which include: Fire Chief, Deputy Fire Chief, Division Chief, Battalion Chief, Fire Captain, Firefighter Engineer, and Firefighter; and

The City of Stockton will compensate its employees portal-to-portal while in the course of their employment and away from their official duty station and assigned to an emergency incident, in support of an emergency incident, or pre-positioned for emergency response; and

The City of Stockton will compensate its employees overtime in accordance with their current Memorandum of Understanding while in the course of their employment and away from their official duty station and assigned to an emergency incident, in support of an emergency incident, or pre-positioned for emergency response; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Personnel shall be compensated according to Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), Personnel Rules and Regulations, and/or directive that identifies personnel compensation in the workplace.

2. In the event a personnel classification does not have an assigned compensation rate, a "Base Rate" as set forth in an organizational policy, administrative directive, or similar document will be used to compensate such personnel.

3. The City of Stockton Fire Department will maintain a current salary survey or acknowledgment of acceptance of the "Base Rate" on file with the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services, Fire Rescue Division.
