# STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

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## RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE 2025 URBAN WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN

The Urban Water Management Planning Act (Water Code, Div. 6, Pt. 2.6, §§ 10610 through 10656) requires urban water suppliers providing over 3,000 acre-feet of water annually or serving 3,000 or more connections to prepare and submit an Urban Water Management Plan (UWMP) to the California Department of Water Resources (DWR) every five years; and

Urban Water Management Plans are intended to provide a guide to manage urban water demands efficiently and to provide long-term water resource planning to ensure adequate and reliable water supplies over a 20-year planning horizon considering normal, dry, and multiple dry years; and

An UWMP is necessary for water agencies to be eligible for State water management grants and loans; and

On September 8, 2025, by Resolution 2025-07-15-1211, the City Council awarded an agreement for Professional Services with Verdantas LLC to prepare the 2025 Urban Water Management Plan (2025 UWMP); and

In accordance with the California Water Code and other applicable laws, MUD staff sent a 60-day notice to all applicable agencies on March 13, 2026, made the 2025 UWMP available for public review before adoption, and published a notice of the Public Hearing time and place in the Stockton Record on May 7, 2026 and May 28, 2026; and

The 2025 UWMP complies with the requirements of the Urban Water Management Planning Act; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves and adopts the 2025 Urban Water Management Plan in accordance with the California Water Code and authorizes its transmittal to the California Department of Water Resources, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

2. Adoption of the 2025 Urban Water Management Plan is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to the California Water Code.

3. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take all necessary actions to carry out the purpose and intent of this resolution and to incorporate any necessary amendments as stipulated by the State Department of Water Resources.
