RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS FROM THE SAN JOAQUIN VALLEY AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT FOR THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL SAFETY AND CONNECTIVITY IMPROVEMENTS, PROJECT NO. WT19005

The Safe Routes to School Safety and Connectivity Improvements, Project No. WT19005, will connect bicycle lanes near several elementary, middle, and high schools in the Stockton community, which will increase safety and provide opportunities for active modes of transportation. The project will also install missing sidewalk segments, high visibility crosswalks, rectangular rapid flashing beacons, signal upgrades, and update curb ramps to Americans with Disabilities Act standards; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Council authorizes the appropriation of grant funds from the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District (Air District) in the amount of \$500,000 to the Safe Routes to School Safety and Connectivity Improvements, Project No. WT19005.
- 2. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to accept grant funds from the Air District in the amount of \$500,000 for the Safe Routes to School Safety and Connectivity Improvements, Project No. WT19005.
- 3. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute all required grant documents, including but not limited to, agreements, amendments, and requests for payment necessary to secure grant funds, and implement the approved grant funded project.
- 4. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
