STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF FOURTEEN VARIOUS PICKUP TRUCKS FROM BIG VALLEY FORD, APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$254,883.60 FROM THE WASTEWATER UTILITY FUND BALANCE, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$308,674.30 FROM THE FLEET INTERNAL SERVICE FUND (PUR16-024)

On February 9, 2017, the City of Stockton received bids from Big Valley Ford and Chase Chevrolet for the purchase of 14 various pickup trucks; and

The purchase will replace 14 various pickup trucks from different departments in service that exceed the age and/or mileage criteria, or have recurring mechanical or operational problems; and

The purchase process was commenced but not completed in Fiscal Year (FY) 2016-17, and the funding that was identified for this purchase was returned to the fund balances. To complete the purchase, these funds need to be appropriated to the FY 2017-18 operating budgets; and

Big Valley Ford is the apparent low bidder in the amount of \$563,557.90 and its bid is regular in all respects; now, therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Manager is authorized to approve the purchase of 14 various pickup trucks from Big Valley Ford.
- 2. The City Council appropriates funds in the amount of \$254,883.60 from the Wastewater Utility Fund fund balance (431-0000-287.00-00) for the purchase of six of the 14 pickup trucks from Big Valley Ford.
- 3. The City Council appropriates funds in the amount of \$308,674.30 from the Fleet Internal Service Fund fund balance (501-0000-101.00-00) for the purchase of eight of the 14 pickup trucks from Big Valley Ford.

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4. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
