RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING FUNDS AND AWARDING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT FOR THE EL DORADO STREET PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLIST SAFETY CONNECTIVITY, PROJECT NO. WT23039/FEDERAL PROJECT NO. HSIPL-5008(210)

On February 26, 2025, the City advertised a Request for Proposals (RFP) for design of the El Dorado Street Pedestrian and Bicyclist Safety Connectivity, Project No. WT23039/Federal Project No. HSIPL-5008(210). Four proposals were received; and

The project will add bicycle improvements and safety features along the corridor including rectangular rapid flashing beacons, crosswalks, bulb outs, bicycle video detection, Class II buffered bicycle lanes and cycle track, median refuge islands, and sidewalks; and

Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. was determined to be the most qualified and second highest ranked firm for this project. Staff negotiated a fee in the amount of \$348,775.95 with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. for design services; and

Transfer of funds is needed for the City's required local match of \$35,000; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the transfer of funds in the amount of \$35,000 from the Grant Match, Project No. WT21016, to the El Dorado Street Pedestrian and Bicyclist Safety Connectivity, Project No. WT23039/Federal Project No. HSIPL-5008(210).

2. The City Council approves findings pursuant to Stockton Municipal Code (SMC) section 3.68.070 in support of an exception to the competitive bidding process. These findings include:

- a. The City does not have sufficient staff and expertise to design this project.
- b. Use of the RFP process is appropriate for this Professional Services Contract because it relies on the evaluation of professional qualifications and performance as the basis for selection of a vendor. Use of the

criteria helps ensure selection of a vendor that will provide the highest quality professional service, which is in the public interest.

- c. The City negotiated a contract following solicitation of competitive proposals in accordance with SMC section 3.68.070.A.3.

3. The City Council awards a Professional Services Contract between the City of Stockton and Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc., in the amount of \$348,775.95, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

4. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
