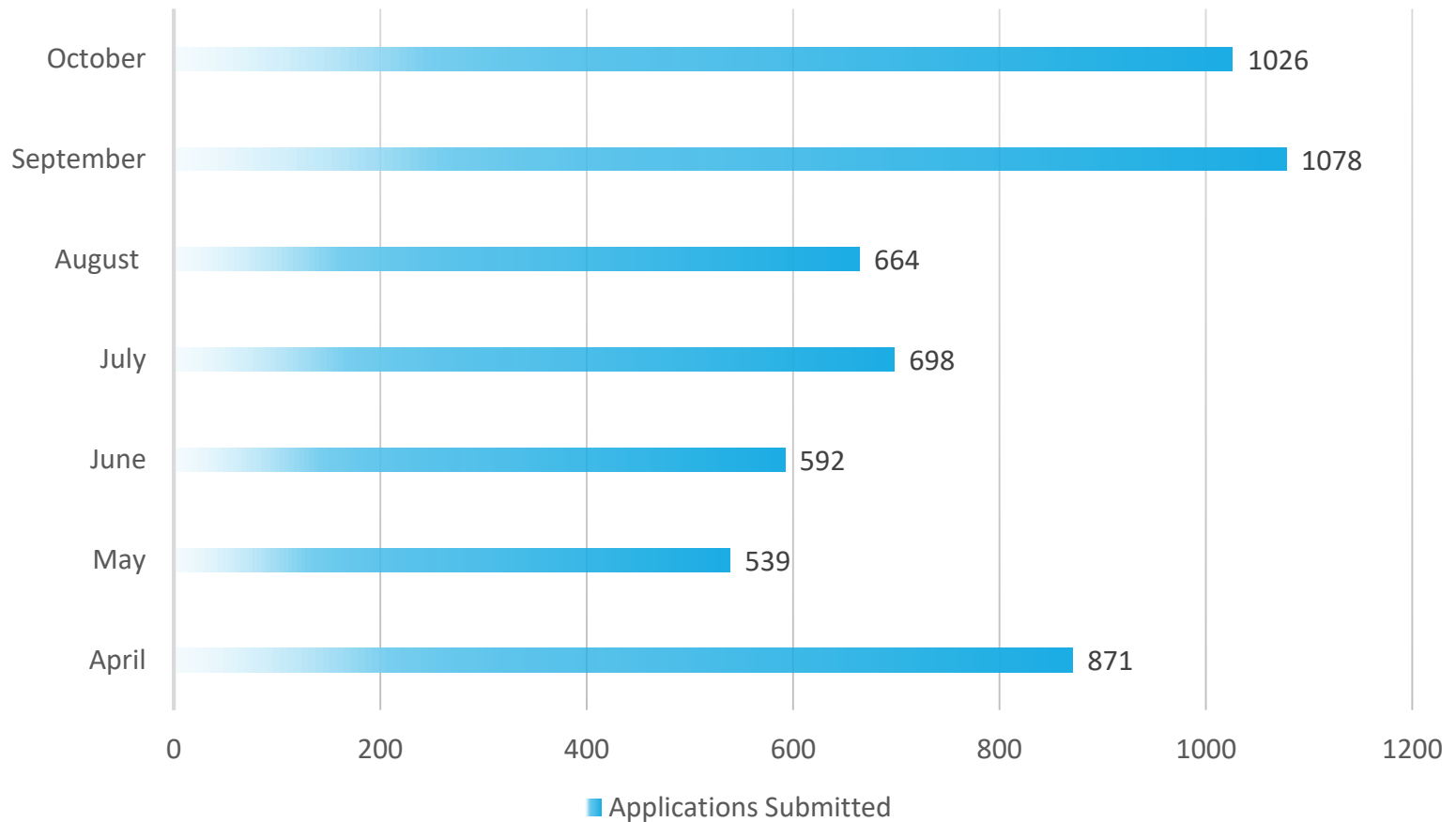
Important Dates

- **January 29, 2021:** SB-91 Signed into Law
- **February 23, 2021:** City Council approved ERAP 1 funding
- **March 15, 2021:** City Program launches
- **June 28, 2021:** Governor signs AB 832
 - 100% of rental arrears and prospective rent
- **September 20, 2021:** 100% of ERAP 1 funds obligated
- **September 30, 2021:** Issued Press Release regarding Eviction Protections
- **November 16, 2021:** Launched Paid Education and Media Campaign
- **November 30, 2021:** Requested additional Treasury Funds

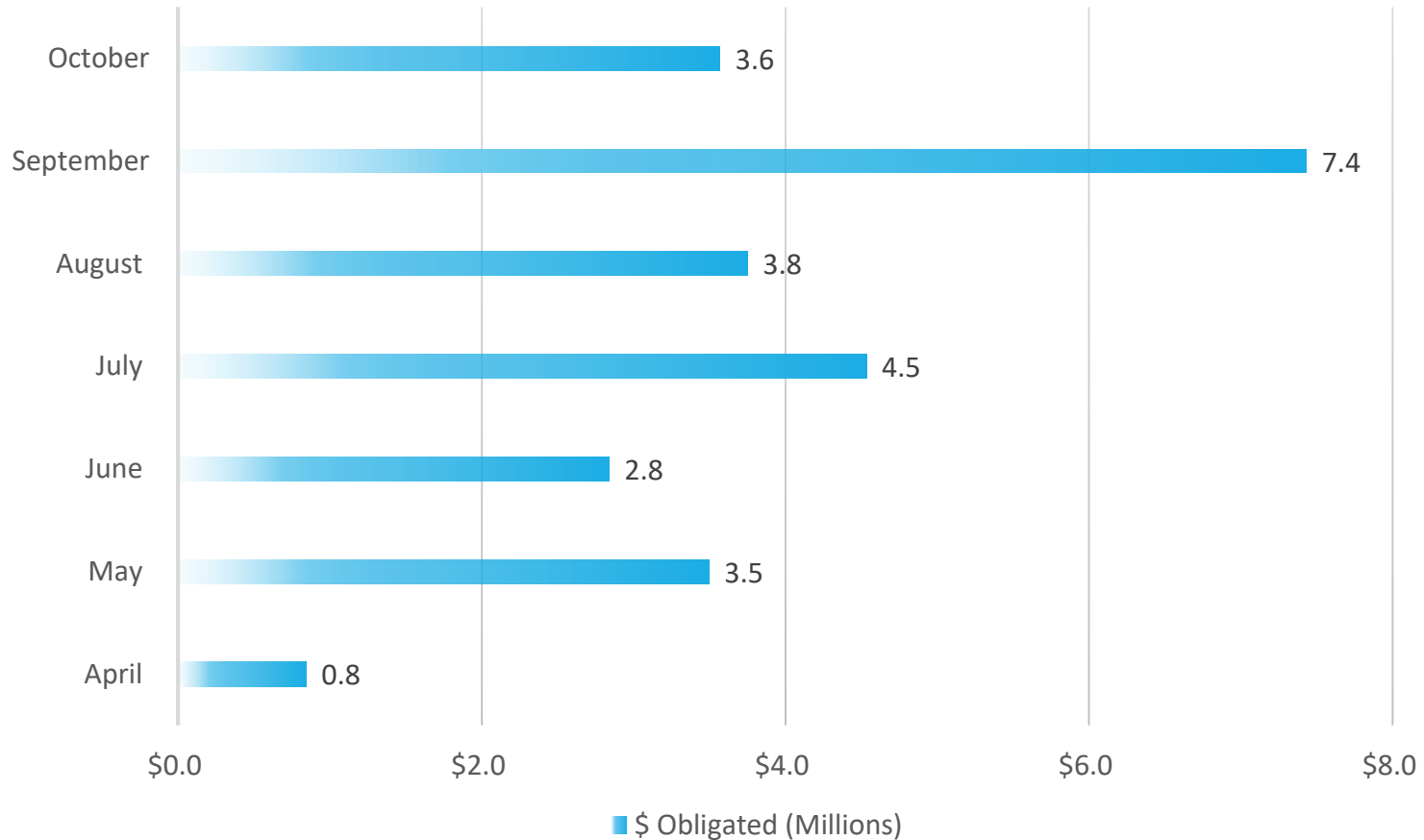
