
#### **Important Dates**

- January 29, 2021: SB-91 Signed into Law
- February 23, 2021: City Council approved ERAP 1 funding
- March 15, 2021: City Program launches
- June 28, 2021: Governor signs AB 832
  - 100% of rental arrears and prospective rent
- September 20, 2021: 100% of ERAP 1 funds obligated
- September 30, 2021: Issued Press Release regarding Eviction Protections
- November 16, 2021: Launched Paid Education and Media Campaign
- November 30, 2021: Requested additional Treasury Funds


