RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A HOMELESSNESS CONCEPT STATEMENT TO BE PRESENTED TO SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY FOR A ONE-TIME CAPITAL OUTLAY GRANT

The County of San Joaquin is making available a grant opportunity for the City of Stockton, and

To meet the parameters set by the County of San Joaquin, the City will issue a NOFA to solicit proponents that have the capability to create low barrier shelter beds; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves a homelessness concept statement to be presented to the San Joaquin County Administrator for feedback prior to submitting a formal one-time capital outlay grant request at some point during the first quarter of 2022.
2. The City Council approves and authorizes the City Manager, or his designee, to submit a concept statement to the San Joaquin County Administrator.
3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
