- 1. The City Council approves a homelessness concept statement to be presented to the San Joaquin County Administrator for feedback prior to submitting a formal one-time capital outlay grant request at some point during the first quarter of 2022.
- 2. The City Council approves and authorizes the City Manager, or his designee, to submit a concept statement to the San Joaquin County Administrator.
- 3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
