RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE ACCEPTANCE OF \$4.3 MILLION CALIFORNIANSFORALL YOUTH DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM GRANT

The City of Stockton ("City") is interested in promoting workforce development programs, particularly those that endeavor to empower high-need youth; and

The State of California has made \$150 million in Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds available to California Volunteers for the purpose of creating the CaliforniansForAll Youth Workforce Development Program; and

Funding for the CaliforniansForAll Youth Workforce Development Program was proportionately awarded to the 13 largest cities in California based on population, resulting in a \$4,355,097 grant for Stockton; and

To receive grant funding, the City must submit an application to California Volunteers; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to apply, accept, and appropriate funds for the CaliforniansForAll Youth Workforce Development Program in the amount of \$4,355,097 and execute all related documents.
- 2. One full-time grant funded position is authorized for the duration of the grant term contingent on available grant funding.
