RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FILING OF NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. NOE11-22, APPROVING THE PROJECT PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$623,135 TO TNT INDUSTRIAL CONTRACTORS, INC. FOR THE REGIONAL WASTEWATER CONTROL FACILITY BIOSCRUBBER REPAIRS (PROJECT NO. UW21011)

On July 28, 2022, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed bids offered for the Regional Wastewater Control Facility (RWCF) Bioscrubber Repairs (Project No. UW21011); and

TNT Industrial Contractors, Inc. is the apparent low bidder in the amount of \$623,135; and

The bid submitted by TNT Industrial Contractors, Inc. is regular and responsive in all aspects; and

The project conforms with the City's General Plan and is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under Article 19, Section 15302, Class 2 (c), of the CEQA Guidelines; The project is in conformance with the Stockton General Plan based on Policy Land Use – 6.3; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Approve the filing of the Notice of Exemption No. NOE11-22 under CEQA for the RWCF Bioscrubber Repairs (Project No. UW21011), a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
- 2. The City Council approves the project Plans and Specifications for the RWCF Bioscrubber Repairs (Project No. UW21011), a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.
- 3. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with TNT Industrial Contractors, Inc. of Sacramento, California, in the amount of \$623,135 for the RWCF Bioscrubber Repairs (Project No. UW21011), a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 3 and incorporated by this reference.
- 4. The City Manager or his designee is authorized and directed to execute all documents, including, but not limited to, agreements and amendments.
