RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) BETWEEN CITY OF STOCKTON AND SAN JOAQUIN COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS FOR THE SUSTAINABLE TRANSPORTATION EQUITY PROJECT (STEP)

The California Air Resources Board (CARB) awarded the San Joaquin Council of Governments a \$7.4 million STEP grant; and

The STEP grant provides funding for clean transportation projects that increase residents' mobility and access to employment opportunities, healthcare, groceries, and other essential services while reducing greenhouse gas emissions; and

SJCOG's STEP grant includes the following components: (1) community engagement, (2) Vamos Mobility-as-a-Service Application, (3) Electric Car Share, (4) Electric Pedal Assist Bicycle Share, (5) E-Workforce Development, and (6) Shared Mobility Incentives; and

SJCOG is interested in partnering with the City of Stockton to implement the Electric Car and Pedal Assist Bicycle Share programs via charging stations hosted at City-owned facilities; and

The City is committed to pursuing partnerships that advance its strategic priorities, including reducing local greenhouse gas emissions and expanding the availability of electric vehicle infrastructure; now, therefore,
