- River Sites- Due to extremely high flows, river access to the Mokelumne and the San Joaquin Rivers remains closed which includes the Mossdale Landing and Dos Reis boat launches. Any organization who must conduct official business on the river must apply for a river access permit through the San Joaquin County Sheriffs Office, located at 7000 Michael Canlis Blvd., French Camp, California. Stillman Magee Day use and campground will remain closed through June 30, 2023. We are asking all visitors to check the San Joaquin County Parks and Recreation website at <u>www.siparks.com</u> for any additional updates. Parks will update the website as additional information becomes available.
- Floating Aquatic Vegetation Control Program- The California Division of Boating and Waterways will be treating portions of the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta for aquatic invasive species including Water Hyacinth, South American Sponge plant, Uruguay Water Primrose and Alligator Weed in the upcoming weeks.
