Accomplishments and Comments

The role of the Advisory Committee is to assure that tax monies collected under Measure A are utilized to implement the Marshall Plan. The Committee has worked diligently this year to understand its roles and responsibilities regarding the review of Measure A sales tax revenue and expenditures. This next year the Advisory Committee will review the expenditures and revenues resulting from Measure A sales tax dollars and report on the progress made towards implementing the Marshall Plan.
