RESOLUTION ALLOCATING THREE CLASSIFIED POSITIONS AND ONE UNCLASSIFIED POSITION FOR PARKING ENFORCEMENT AND MANAGEMENT AND APPROVING A REVISED PARKING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014 – 2105

In Fiscal Year 2011-12, the City of Stockton ("City") defaulted on its parking bond debt service payment. As a result, the City lost control of the Coy, Arena, and Market Street garages. The City negotiated with the National Public Finance Guarantee Corporation ("NPFG") to regain operational control of the garages, and both parties agreed that improvements in operations and revenue generation were needed; and

In October 2013 the City contracted with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. ("Consultant") to conduct a comprehensive review and assessment of the City's parking program operations and facilities; and

The Consultant's report recommended outsourcing parking operations and management, hiring a parking manager, and transferring enforcement from the Police Department to the Parking Authority in accordance with the requirements of the settlement agreement with NPFG; and

The Parking Authority, by motion, approved an agreement with SP Plus Corporation on December 16, 2014, to operate and manage the parking facilities within the Downtown Parking District ("District"); and

Current Police Department employees assigned to enforcement within the District will not be impacted and will receive new assignments; and

To implement the remaining settlement deal points and consultant recommendations, three classified positions are needed to conduct parking enforcement within the District: a Supervising Parking Enforcement Officer and two Parking Enforcement Officers; and

To oversee the Parking Operator contract, enforcement, technology, and equipment improvements, and other asset management functions, an unclassified position of Program Manager III, is needed; and

These positions will be City employees assigned to the Parking Division within the Economic Development Department; and

It is necessary to revise the Central Parking District fund 416 annual budget (Exhibit 1) and the Parking Fee Schedule (Exhibit 2) for Fiscal Year 2014-2015 to incorporate these recommendations; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Council hereby approves the allocation of:
 - a. Three (3) classified positions for Parking Enforcement within the District
 - i. One (1) Supervising Parking Enforcement Officer
 - ii. Two (2) Parking Enforcement Officers
 - b. One (1) unclassified position of Program Manager III to oversee and manage the parking programs and asset management.
- 2. The revised Fiscal Year 2014-2015 budget for the Central Parking District fund 416, attached as Exhibit 1, is approved.
- 3. The revised Fiscal Year 2014-2015 Fee Schedule for the Central Parking District, attached as Exhibit 2, is approved.
- 4. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take any and all actions deemed necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
