The City of Stockton (City) seeks to file an application for elective coverage of State Disability Insurance (SDI) with the State of California Employment Department for members of the Mid Management/Supervisory Level Unit (B&C); and

Section 14.5 of the B&C Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) provides for their membership, upon election, to receive SDI coverage at their own expense; and

On May 14, 2015, SCEA notified the City that their membership had voted and elected to participate in elective coverage of SDI; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. In accordance with Section 14.5 of the B&C MOU, and pursuant to California Unemployment Insurance Code section 710.5, the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to file an application with the State of California, Employment Development Department for elective coverage of SDI for B&C members.
- 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this resolution.
