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RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FILING OF NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. CE008-15 FOR THE 2014 SANITARY SEWER MAINTENANCE HOLE REHABILITATION (PROJECT NO. M15004), APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO SOCAL PACIFIC CONSTRUCTION CORP., IN THE AMOUNT OF \$310,740

On May 7, 2015, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the 2014 Sanitary Sewer Maintenance Hole Rehabilitation (Project No. M15004); and

SoCal Pacific Construction Corp., is the apparent low bidder in the amount of \$310,740; and

The project is therefore awarded to SoCal Pacific Construction Corp., the lowest bidder, in the amount of \$310,740, because its bid is regular and responsive in all respects; and

This project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under Article 19, Section 15301, (Existing Facilities) Class 1, and Section 15302, (Replacement or Reconstruction) Class 2, of the CEQA Guidelines and is also in conformance with the City's General Plan pursuant to California Government Code section 65402; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Manager is authorized to approve the filing of Notice of Exemption No. CE008-15 under CEQA for the 2014 Sanitary Sewer Maintenance Hole Rehabilitation (Project No. M15004), a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
- 2. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the 2014 Sanitary Sewer Maintenance Hole Rehabilitation (Project No. M15004).
- 3. A Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and SoCal Pacific Construction Corp., in the amount of \$310,740, is hereby approved and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

4. The City Manager or his designee is authorized and directed to execute all documents, including but not limited to any agreements and amendments.
