## STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$345,000, FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY FOR THE AVOID THE 10 DUI CAMPAIGN FOR THE PERIOD OCTOBER 1, 2015, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2016

In January 2015, the Stockton Police Department submitted a Memorandum Proposal to the State of California Office of Traffic Safety requesting consideration to participate in the AVOID the 10 DUI Campaign ("Program"); and

The Program is administered by the California Office of Traffic Safety and funding for this program is provided by a grant through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration; and

The Police Department's proposal included "best practice" strategies to be conducted on an overtime basis to help reduce the number of individuals killed or injured in alcohol-involved crashes; and

Under the AVOID the 10 DUI Campaign, missions would be conducted by participating agencies during the Winter Holiday Mobilization period which is generally mid-December through New Year's Day; Memorial Day Weekend; Independence Day Weekend/Period; the Summer Mobilization period, including the two weeks prior to Labor Day; and any special dates, county fairs, festivals, and other community events; and

In June 2015, the Police Department received notification from the State of California Office of Traffic Safety indicating that its proposal was accepted for funding in the amount of \$345,000; and

The Grant Agreement, attached as Exhibit 1, outlines the terms and conditions under which funds will be used to pay for DUI enforcement overtime, training, costs from participating agencies, and miscellaneous materials and supplies; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to accept the grant award in the amount of \$345,000 for the period October 1, 2015, through September 30, 2016, and make all necessary appropriations in compliance with and for the purposes stated in the grant application.

2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Grant Agreement attached as Exhibit 1 and all related documents, and to take all necessary and appropriate actions to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
