RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FILING OF NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. MUD-CE-2-15, APPROVING THE PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS, AND ADDENDA, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO NMI INDUSTRIAL HOLDINGS, INC. FOR THE EIGHTH STREET STORMWATER PUMP STATION TRASH RACK REPAIR (PROJECT NO. M14019)

On June 4, 2015, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the Eighth Street Stormwater Pump Station Trash Rack Repair (Project No. M14019); and

NMI Industrial Holdings, Inc. was the apparent low bidder in the amount of \$84,207; and

The project is therefore awarded to NMI Industrial Holdings, Inc.; and

This project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under Article 19, Section 15302(c), Class 2 of the CEQA Guidelines; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Manager is authorized to approve the filing of Notice of Exemption No. MUD-CE-2-15 under CEQA for the Eighth Street Stormwater Pump Station Trash Rack Repair project, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
- 2. The City Council approves the plans, specifications, and addenda for the Eighth Street Stormwater Pump Station Trash Rack Repair project.
- 3. A Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and NMI Industrial Holdings, Inc., in the amount of \$84,207, for the Eighth Street Stormwater Pump Station Trash Rack Repair is hereby awarded and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

4. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
