RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF ALEXIS STEVENS TO THE COUNCIL WATER COMMITTEE'S WATER ADVISORY GROUP

The City of Stockton Municipal Utilities Department (MUD) provides potable water; wastewater collection, treatment, and disposal; and stormwater collection and disposal. In an effort to foster citizen input and transparency in MUD's operations, the City Council authorized the formation of a Water Advisory Group whose purpose is to provide input and information to the Council Water Committee on issues impacting Water, Wastewater, and Stormwater; and

Positions on the Water Advisory Group coincide with the appointing Councilmember's term; and

Due to the resignation of Committee Member Art Paullus there is a vacancy for the position appointed by Councilmember Lofthus (District 3); and

The City Clerk recruited for interested applicants; and

A total of five applications were received that met the guidelines established by Council (Resolution 09-0279) for consideration; and

Councilmember Lofthus reviewed the applications and is recommending Alexis Stevens to fill the vacant position on the Water Advisory Group; now, therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS
FOLLOWS:**

1. The following applicant is found to meet the criteria for appointment and is authorized to serve as a member of the Council Water Committee's Water Advisory Group for a term to commence on appointment and ending January 31, 2019:

Alexis Stevens - Appointment by Councilmember Lofthus, District 3

2. The City Manager is authorized to take such other actions as are appropriate to carry out the intent of this Resolution.
