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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR THE CITY MANAGER'S DESIGNEE TO SIGN ALL CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION RIGHT-OF-WAY CERTIFICATIONS

The City of Stockton constructs many projects each year using Federal and State funds; and

For the City of Stockton to receive funds for construction of a project, a Right-of-Way Certification must be approved by the California Department of Transportation; and

The most current resolution authorizing the Public Works Director to sign Right-of-Way Certifications was adopted by Council on May 17, 1993, (Resolution No. 93-0295) which designated and named the Public Works Director at that time; and

The California Department of Transportation has requested an updated resolution to authorize the City Manager or their designee to sign all Caltrans Right-of-Way Certifications; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS
FOLLOWS:

1. The City Manager is authorized to sign all California Department of Transportation Right-of-Way Certifications.

2. The City Manager is authorized to designate another Deputy City Manager or Department Director to sign on behalf of the City Manager. The designee shall be by written notification from the City Manager and kept on file with the California Department of Transportation, District 10.

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3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take appropriate and necessary actions to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
