## STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

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### RESOLUTION CANCELING AND RESCHEDULING THE MAY 24, 2016 PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER ADOPTION OF PROPOSED WATER RATE INCREASES

By Resolution 2016-03-29-1506, the Stockton City Council authorized a Public Hearing to be held on May 24, 2016 to consider the adoption of proposed increases in the rates for its water service charges; and

The Stockton City Council further directed that a notice of the public hearing be mailed not less than forty-five days in advance of the Public Hearing; and

Since the notice of the May 24, 2016 Public Hearing was mailed, the City has been able to achieve additional costs savings by reducing its purchased water commitments and debt obligations for the water utility; and

As a result, the City has been able to reduce the proposed rate increases that were included in the notice for the May 24, 2016 Public Hearing; and

The Stockton City Council has determined to cancel the May 24, 2016 Public Hearing, and authorize and direct the City Manager to reschedule the Public Hearing and mail a new notice of the rescheduled Public Hearing; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Public Hearing on the adoption of the proposed increases in the rates for water service charges scheduled for the Stockton City Council meeting of May 24, 2016, is hereby canceled.

2. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to schedule a new Public Hearing for the purpose of considering the adoption of the revised schedule of increases in the rates for the City's water service charges and to mail notice of the Public Hearing to all record owners of parcels upon which the water service charges are proposed for imposition, and any tenants who are directly responsible for the payment of water service charges (i.e., a customer of record who is not a property owner). The notice shall include the updated schedule of rates and proposed rate adjustments. The Public Hearing shall be scheduled not less than forty-five days after the notice of the Public Hearing has been mailed. A copy of the notice is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

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3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take necessary and appropriate actions to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
