

# STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

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## **RESOLUTION APPROVING FINDINGS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A COOPERATIVE PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR LEASE OF CANON XEROGRAPHIC SYSTEM FOR 60 MONTHS WITH RAY MORGAN COMPANY OF ROSEVILLE, THROUGH THE SHASTA UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT (SUHSD) MASTER ENABLING AGREEMENT (COOPERATIVE)**

The City of Stockton previously adopted Resolution 10-0390 to acquire a Canon high-speed xerographic system through PEPPM Technology Bidding and Purchasing Program with Canon U.S.A., Inc.; and

Said Agreement expired on April 28, 2016, and allows provisions for additional 12 monthly payments, if necessary; and

The SUHSD Master Enabling Agreement provides cooperative pricing specific for reproduction equipment leased from Ray Morgan Company, a Canon dealer located in Roseville, CA; and

The City has negotiated a lease agreement for these equipment and maintenance for 60 months with Ray Morgan Company for an estimated annual cost of \$69,216; and

Stockton Municipal Code Section 3.68.70 provides for an exception to the competitive bidding requirements for contracts in cases where the City Council has approved findings which support and justify exceptions to the competitive bidding process; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Council hereby approves the following finding which support the lease of a Canon xerographic system through the SUHSD Master Enabling Agreement as follows:
  - a. The SUHSD established a cooperative purchasing agreement for the lease of technology equipment, software, and supplies on behalf of schools, agencies, and libraries after undergoing a formal competitive bidding process that sought and awarded bids.
  - b. The bid specifications used by the SUHSD Master Enabling Agreement were assessed considering the City's central reprographic standards of quality and efficiency. Ray Morgan Company was selected by SUHSD as the supplier for the Canon equipment.
  - c. The SUHSD Master Enabling Agreement is bidding primarily on behalf of educational agencies, however, the program extends

the bid protections and price discounts to governments, municipalities, and related county/municipal authorities, and other non-profit organizations.

2. Based on these finding and pursuant to Stockton Municipal Code Section 3.68.070, the City Council hereby declare that an exception to the competitive bidding process is justified and authorized the City Manager, on behalf of the City of Stockton, to lease a Canon xerographic system that includes two separate copiers, for 60 months, with Ray Morgan Company through the SUHSD Master Enabling Agreement.
3. The City Manager is authorized to take such other actions as are appropriate and necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution.
