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RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FILING OF NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. CE003-15 UNDER THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, TRANSFER FUNDING, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO ROBERT BURNS CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE FIRE STATION NO. 10 DRIVEWAY AND PARKING LOT (PROJECT NO. PW1412)

On April 14, 2016, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the Fire Station No. 10 Driveway and Parking Lot (Project No. PW1412); and

Robert Burns Construction, Inc. is the apparent low bidder in the amount of \$119,090.75; and

The project is therefore awarded to Robert Burns Construction, Inc., the lowest bidder, in the amount of \$119,090.75, because its bid is regular and responsive in all respects; and

This project is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under Article 19, Section 15301, Class 1 of the CEQA Guidelines because it is a project that has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment and is therefore exempt from the provisions of CEQA; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Manager is authorized to approve the filing of Notice of Exemption No. CE003-15 under CEQA for this project, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

2. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the Fire Station No. 10 Driveway and Parking Lot (Project No. PW1412).

3. The City Manager is authorized to transfer funding from the Fire Station No. 6 Apparatus Bay Exhaust Fan Installation (Project No. PW1511) in the amount of \$30,000 (PW1511; 301-3020-640) to the Fire Station No. 10 Driveway and Parking Lot (Project No. PW1412), and cancel the Fire Station No. 6 Apparatus Bay Exhaust Fan Installation project.

4. A Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and Robert Burns Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$119,090.75, is hereby approved, and the City

Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

5. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take appropriate and necessary actions to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
