

# STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

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## **RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF STOCKTON TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000 FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL GRANT ASSISTANCE TO LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES PROJECT**

The City of Stockton ("City") is interested in participating in the Grant Assistance to Local Law Enforcement Agencies Project, which is made available through the Grant Assistance Program administered by the State of California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control for the purpose of reducing the number of nuisances in the state's Alcoholic Beverage Control licensed establishments/locations in the City; and

Following the City's submittal of a proposal for the Project, the State of California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control offered to award \$100,000 for the one-year grant program, beginning July 1, 2016, and ending June 30, 2017; and

Grant funds will be used to pay overtime costs for police officers in the Police Department's Special Investigations Section to conduct state Alcoholic Beverage Control enforcement, along with operating expenses, equipment, and travel to implement an alcoholic beverage control enforcement program; and

In order to be considered eligible to receive grant funding, the City must submit a completed Grant Award Contract to the State of California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control; now, therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS  
FOLLOWS:**

1. The City Manager or a designated representative is hereby authorized, on behalf of the City, to accept grant funding in the amount of \$100,000 from the State of California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control.

2. The City Manager or a designated representative is hereby authorized and directed, on behalf of the City, to execute the grant documents and to submit all documents including, without limitation, contracts, amendments, extensions, and payment requests as appropriate to accept the funds under and comply with the conditions of the grant.

3. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to establish all required accounts and make any and all expenditures, appropriations, transfers, and/or distributions of funds on behalf of the City as appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.

4. The City recognizes that any liability arising out of the performance of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Grant, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California and the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control disclaim responsibility for any such liability.

5. Grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant ongoing law enforcement expenditures.

6. Any personnel positions approved for the funding under this proposal shall be filled without unnecessary delay and shall not be subject to local hiring freezes.
