Text for Publication in the Record *	<p>CITY OF STOCKTON INTENTION TO GRANT OR SELL REAL PROPERTY INTEREST NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Tuesday, July 26, 2016, at 5:30 p.m., in the Council Chambers, 425 North El Dorado Street, the Stockton City Council will consider a resolution to lease property owned by the City of Stockton. The Stockton City Council will consider a resolution to amend the lease of 67.12 acres of excess land located at 11373 Lower Sacramento Road, Stockton, CA, to Roy Yates in the amount of \$2,560 per year. The amendment will extend the term of the lease to five years, retaining the original commencement date of September 1, 2014, but terminating on August 31, 2019. Included in the amendment is an option to renew the lease up to an additional five years, in one (1) five-year increment. Anyone wishing to be heard on the above matter may appear before the City Council at the time of the public hearing and/or may file a written opinion with the City Clerk, 425 North El Dorado Street, Stockton, CA, prior to the public hearing. If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or prior to, the public hearing. All proceedings before the City Council are conducted in English. The City of Stockton does not furnish interpreters and, if one is needed, it shall be the responsibility of the person needing one. In accordance with the Americans With Disabilities Act and California Law, it is the policy of the City of Stockton to offer its public programs, services and meetings in a manner that is readily accessible to everyone, including those with disabilities.
