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RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FILING OF NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. CE015-16, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO SOCAL PACIFIC CONSTRUCTION CORPORATION DBA NATIONAL COATING AND LINING COMPANY FOR THE 2015 SANITARY SEWER MAINTENANCE HOLE REHABILITATION (PROJECT NO. M16005)

On July 28, 2016, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the 2015 Sanitary Sewer Maintenance Hole Rehabilitation (Project No. M16005); and

The project will repair and seal the interior surface of 60 sewer maintenance holes throughout the City that are severely deteriorated; and

SoCal Pacific Construction Corporation dba National Coating and Lining Company is the apparent low bidder in the amount of \$392,050; and

The project is, therefore, awarded to SoCal Pacific Construction Corporation dba National Coating and Lining Company, the lowest bidder, in the amount of \$392,050, because its bid is regular and responsive in all respects; and

This project is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under Article 19, Sections 15301, Class 1, and 15302, Class 2, of the CEQA Guidelines, because this is a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Manager is authorized to approve the filing of Notice of Exemption No. CE015-16 under CEQA for the 2015 Sanitary Sewer Maintenance Hole Rehabilitation (Project No. M16005), a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

2. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the 2015 Sanitary Sewer Maintenance Hole Rehabilitation (Project No. M16005).

3. A Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and SoCal Pacific Construction Corporation dba National Coating and Lining Company, in the amount of

\$392,050, is hereby awarded, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

4. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take appropriate and necessary actions to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
