RESOLUTION APPROVING AN EXCLUSIVE NEGOTIATING RIGHTS AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF STOCKTON AND STOCKTONIANS TAKING ACTION TO NEUTRALIZE DRUGS, FOR A PROPOSED MIXED-USE RETAIL DEVELOPMENT PROJECT IN SOUTH STOCKTON

The City of Stockton (the "City") owns property in South Stockton, inclusive of County Assessor Parcel Numbers 169-163-01 and 169-151-01; and

Stocktonians Taking Action to Neutralize Drugs (STAND), a California 501(c)(3) Public Benefit Non Profit Corporation, (the "Developer") has submitted a proposal which includes construction of a mixed-use, infill development project; and

The Developer's proposal includes properties owned by the City of Stockton; and

The City supports the proposed project and wishes to execute an Exclusive Negotiating Rights Agreement in order to negotiate with the Developer; and

The City would enter into a 180-day Exclusive Negotiating Rights Agreement with Developer during the term of which City and Developer will negotiate the business terms of a Purchase Option and/or Sales Agreement for the project and any other assistance as necessary to undertake the proposed project; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City finds and declares that STAND, has the expertise necessary to develop the proposed Project outlined in its proposal, attached as Exhibit B to the Exclusive Negotiating Rights Agreement, which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

2. STAND, is granted a period of 180 days as an exclusive negotiating period in which to negotiate the terms and conditions of a Purchase Option and/or Sales Agreement between Developer and City in connection with the proposed Project.

// // 3. The City Manager is authorized and directed to execute an Exclusive Negotiating Rights Agreement with STAND, and take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this resolution.
