RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO MCFADDEN CONSTRUCTION, INC., AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF STOCKTON AND THE GREATER VALLEY CONSERVATION CORPS (FORMERLY SAN JOAQUIN REGIONAL CONSERVATION CORPS) FOR THE SAN JOAQUIN TRAIL (PROJECT NO. PW1442/ATPL 5008(139))

On September 22, 2016, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the San Joaquin Trail (Project No. PW1442/ATPL 5008(139)); and

The project will rehabilitate and widen 2.6 miles of existing trail. The improvements will also install signage and striping, bicycle racks, drinking fountains, trash receptacles, benches, minor landscaping, and upgrade existing ramps to Americans with Disabilities Act standards; and

McFadden Construction, Inc. is the apparent low bidder in the amount of \$878,433; and

The project is, therefore, awarded to McFadden Construction, Inc., the lowest responsible bidder, in the amount of \$878,433, because its bid is regular and responsive in all respects; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the San Joaquin Trail (Project No. PW1442/ATPL-5008(139)).
- 2. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute an Agreement between the City of Stockton and the Greater Valley Conservation Corps (formerly San Joaquin Regional Conservation Corps) in the amount of \$16,138.78, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
- 3. A Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and McFadden Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$878,433, is hereby awarded, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

4. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take appropriate and necessary actions to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
