## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT WITH COCA-COLA CO. FOR POURING RIGHTS AT THE ENTERTAINMENT VENUES AND VENDING THROUGHOUT CITY FACILITIES

Since 2002, the City has been operating under an agreement with Coca-Cola for exclusive vending and pouring rights at various city facilities, which is currently operating on a month-to-month basis; and

Since 2005, the Entertainment Venues (Arena, Ball Park, Oak Park Ice Rink, and the Bob Hope Theatre), have operated under a different pouring rights agreement with Pepsi Co., which is also currently operating on a month-to-month basis; and

The City would be able to generate more revenue if the Entertainment Venues and other City properties were combined into one pouring rights agreement; and

Council approved the use of a RFP process by SMG on behalf of the City to select a Pouring Rights company through a Motion (Report 13-0916); and

SMG issued a RFP and following review of the proposals by a panel consisting of a third party, SMG, and City staff, selected Coca-Cola's proposal, as it was in the best interest of the City; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Manager of the City of Stockton is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Agreement with BCI Coca Cola Bottling Bottler of Los Angeles (Coca Cola) for Pouring Rights (exclusive beverage provider) for both the Entertainment Venues and specific City properties, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
- 2. In accordance with section 6504 of the Government Code, this project/activity has been determined to conform to the City's General Plan Policy Document, as amended.
