## RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO ROBERT BURNS CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC CALMING PROGRAM (2017 SPEED HUMP, SPEED CUSHION, AND SPEED TABLE), PROJECT NO. PW1608

On December 22, 2016, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program (2017 Speed Hump, Speed Cushion, and Speed Table), Project No. PW1608; and

The project will provide a process for installation of traffic calming measures to slow traffic on neighborhood streets; and

Robert Burns Construction, Inc. is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder in the amount of \$361,607.50; and

The project is, therefore, awarded to Robert Burns Construction, Inc., the lowest bidder, in the amount of \$361,607.50, because its bid is regular and responsive in all respects; now, therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program (2017 Speed Hump, Speed Cushion, and Speed Table), Project No. PW1608.

2. A Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and Robert Burns Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$361,607.50, is hereby awarded, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference. The Construction Contract includes two optional one-year extensions that must be mutually agreed to by both City and Contractor.

3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take appropriate and necessary actions to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
