Renee Puig-Hink has applied to fill the vacancy and meets requirements of Builders' Exchange of Stockton Executive, and currently serves as Executive Director of that organization; now, therefore,

Renee Puig-Hink is hereby appointed to the Development Oversight Commission to fill the vacancy of Michael Self for the remainder of the current five-year term of the Commission which began on October 20, 2014.
