RESOLUTION RESCINDING THE RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO RENEW THE MIRACLE MILE PROPERTY AND BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT ADOPTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON MAY 23, 2017

2. The City Manager is authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this resolution.
