RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF STOCKTON TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000 FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL GRANT ASSISTANCE TO LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES PROJECT AND APPROVING THE AMENDMENT OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2017-18 ANNUAL BUDGET

The City of Stockton (City) is interested in participating in the Grant Assistance to Local Law Enforcement Agencies Project, which is made available through the Grant Assistance Program administered by the State of California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) for the purpose of reducing the number of nuisances in the state's Alcoholic Beverage Control licensed establishments/locations in the City; and

Following the City's submittal of a proposal for the Project, the (ABC) offered to award \$100,000 for the one-year grant program beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2018; and

Grant Funds will be used to pay overtime costs for police officers in the Police Department's Special Investigations Section to conduct state ABC enforcement, along with operating expenses, equipment, and travel to implement an Alcoholic Beverage Control enforcement program; and

In order to be considered eligible to receive grant funding, the City must execute the Grant Award Contract, attached as Exhibit 1, to the ABC; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Manager or a designated representative is hereby authorized, on behalf of the City, to accept grant funding in the amount of \$100,000 from the State of California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control.
- 2. The Fiscal Year (FY) 2017-18 Annual Budget is amended to appropriate \$100,000 in revenues and expenditures for the Other Special Revenue Programs ABC Grant Program in the Police Grants & Special Programs Fund budget.
- 3. The City Manager or a designated representative is hereby authorized and directed, on behalf of the City, to execute the grant documents, attached as Exhibit 1, and to submit all documents, including, without limitation, contracts, amendments, extensions, and payment requests as appropriate to accept the funds under and comply with the conditions of the grant.

- 4. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to establish all required accounts and make any and all expenditures, appropriations, transfers, and/or distributions of funds on behalf of the City as appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
- 5. The City recognizes that any liability arising out of the performance of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Grant, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The ABC disclaim responsibility for any such liability.
- 6. Grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant ongoing law enforcement expenditures.
- 7. Any personnel positions approved for the funding under this proposal shall be filled without unnecessary delay and shall not be subject to local hiring freezes.
