RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. CE0011-17, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE STOCKTON POLICE DEPARTMENT UNDER FREEWAY PARKING LOT IMPROVEMENTS (PROJECT NO. PW1621)

On April 20, 2017, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the Stockton Police Department (PD) Under Freeway Parking Lot Improvements (Project No. PW1621); and

The project will resurface and reconfigure PD Parking Lots 2 and 3, and will include upgrades to fencing and parking lot access; and

Robert Burns Construction, Inc. is the apparent low bidder in the amount of \$1,097,141.80 and its bid is regular in all respects; and

The project is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under Article 19, section 153301, Class 1, of the CEQA Guidelines, because this is a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Manager is authorized to approve the filing of Notice of Exemption No. CE0011-17 under CEQA for the PD Under Freeway Parking Lot Improvements (Project No. PW1621), a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
- 2. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the PD Under Freeway Parking Lot Improvements (Project No. PW1621).
- 3. A Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and Robert Burns Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$1,097,141.80, is hereby awarded, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

4. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
