Stockton, CA – San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) and Uber are working together to bring residents...to the places they want to go! Effective now, many passengers can save 50 percent, up to \$5.00 per ride, when riding with Uber in San Joaquin County.

Many people in San Joaquin County need a ride but live outside the area serviced by RTD buses. The "RTD GO!" promotion on Uber will enable people to travel from outside the normal RTD service area to popular destinations in San Joaquin County for less, according to RTD Chief Executive Officer, Donna DeMartino.

"RTD GO!" is available in San Joaquin County, Monday through Friday, 6:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. This schedule adds transportation options both earlier and later than most regular RTD service.
