RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FILING OF NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. CE08-18 APPROVING THE SPECIFICATIONS AND AWARDED A CONTRACT TO SYNAGRO–WWT, INC. FOR DIGESTER NO. 5 CLEANING (PROJECT NO. P17015)

On March 22, 2018, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly read the sealed bids offered for the Digester No. 5 Cleaning Project No. P17015; and

SYNAGRO–WWT, INC. of BALTIMORE, MD was the apparent low bidder in the amount of \$483,968; and

The bid submitted by SYNAGRO-WWT, INC. is regular and responsive in all respects; and

This project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under Article 19, section 15330(b)(5); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the specifications for the Regional Wastewater Control Facility Digester No. 5 Cleaning Project No. P17015.

2. A Contract between the City of Stockton and SYNAGRO-WWT, Inc. for Digester No. 5 Cleaning, Project No. P17015, in the amount of \$483,968 is hereby awarded, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

3. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to file the Notice of Exemption No. CE08-18 under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) for the Regional Wastewater Control Facility Digester No. 5 Cleaning, Project No. P17015, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

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4. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
