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RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. CE045-17, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE 2016 SANITARY SEWER REHABILITATION, PROJECT NO. M16006

On March 22, 2018, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the 2016 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation, Project No. M16006; and

The project is part of an annual program to rehabilitate existing sewer lines to address concerns regarding pipe condition, inadequate sizing, and the potential for failure; and

McFadden Construction, Inc. is the apparent low bidder in the amount of \$421,311 and its bid is regular and responsive in all respects; and

The project is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under Article 19, Section 15301, Class 1, of the CEQA Guidelines, because this is a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Council approves the filing of Notice of Exemption No. CE045-17 under CEQA for the 2016 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation, Project No. M16006, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
- 2. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the 2016 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation, Project No. M16006.
- 3. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and McFadden Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$421,311, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.
