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RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. CE023-17, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, APPROPRIATING \$35,000 FROM THE MEASURE K MAINTENANCE FUND BALANCE AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE RESPONSIVE TRAFFIC SIGNAL CONTROL SYSTEM ON EL DORADO STREET (PROJECT NO. PW1421/FEDERAL PROJECT NO. HSIPL-5008(137))

On March 8, 2018, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the Responsive Traffic Signal Control System on El Dorado Street (Project No. PW1421/Federal Project No. HSIPL-5008(137)); and

The project will install a traffic responsive traffic control system on El Dorado Street at eight signalized intersections between Duncan and Alpine Avenues. The system will monitor traffic flow and select the pre-set timing plan that best matches the actual conditions, resulting in better vehicle progression along the corridor, reduced stops and delays, and improved air quality and roadway safety; and

The project will install additional vehicle detection, upgrade traffic signals, and upgrade pedestrian signals at selected intersections; and

Tim Paxin's Pacific Excavation, Inc. is the apparent low bidder in the amount of \$219,320, and its bid is regular and responsive in all respects; and

Caltrans National Environmental Policy Act determination was received on July 31, 2017. The State determined that the project is a Categorical Exclusion under 23 CFR 771.117(c): activity (c) (21). Similarly, the project is in conformance with the City's General Plan, pursuant to California Government Code section 65402; and

The project is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under Article 19, section 15301, Class 1 of the CEQA Guidelines, because this is a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the filing of Notice of Exemption No. CE023-17 under CEQA for the Responsive Traffic Signal Control System on

El Dorado Street (Project No. PW1421/Federal Project No. HSIPL-5008(137)), a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

2. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the Responsive Traffic Signal Control System on El Dorado Street (Project No. PW1421/Federal Project No. HSIPL-5008(137)).

3. The City Council approves the appropriation of \$35,000 from Measure K Maintenance Fund balance (Fund 082) to the Responsive Traffic Signal Control System on El Dorado Street (Project No. PW1421/Federal Project No. HSIPL-5008(137)).

4. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and Tim Paxin's Pacific Excavation, Inc., in the amount of \$219,320, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

5. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
