WHEREAS, 36% of young adults in San Joaquin County between the ages of 18-39 have been diagnosed with pre-diabetes or diabetes; and

WHEREAS, 1 in 3 children will develop type 2 diabetes in their lifetimes due to the consumption of sugary sweetened beverages and chances are higher for Latino and African American children, where 1 in 2 will develop type 2 diabetes; and

WHEREAS, people who drink 1 or 2 sugary sweetened beverages per day have a 26% higher risk of developing type 2 diabetes; and

WHEREAS, the 2017 The Organizing and Leadership Academy (TOLA) health survey of approximately 6,000 Stockton residents found that nearly 40% of respondents consumed sugar sweetened beverages at least once a day, almost 60% consumed sugary beverages on a regular basis, and over 60% reported diabetes as part of their family health histories; and

WHEREAS, healthy living means providing workshops, resources, and programming that will educate families on how to eat healthier and consume less sugary beverages; and

WHEREAS, children are more physically active when parks and streets are safer as this helps parents to comfortably allow them to play outside; and

WHEREAS, the city must acknowledge the need for more community places that promote physical and educational activities for children and families; and

WHEREAS, the City of Stockton hereby encourages its residents to take action and combat the unhealthy eating habits and lifestyle that have plagued our community.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MICHAEL TUBBS, as Mayor of the City of Stockton, and on behalf of the Stockton City Council, do hereby declare July 17, 2018 as

STOCKTON DIABETES AWARENESS DAY

and call upon all Stocktonians, school districts, government agencies, nonprofit organizations, health care providers, and other interested parties to join in activities that raise diabetes awareness and help prevent, treat, and manage the disease.
