STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF 23 POLICE INTERCEPTOR UTILITY VEHICLES AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$776,869.85 FROM THE FLEET INTERNAL SERVICE FUND (PUR 18-013)

On May 24, 2018, the City of Stockton received two bids for the purchase of 23 Police Interceptor Utility Vehicles; and

The purchase will replace 23 police patrol vehicles in service that exceed the age and/or mileage criteria, or have recurring mechanical or operational problems; and

The purchase process was commenced but not completed in Fiscal Year (FY) 2017-18, and the funding that was identified for this purchase was returned to the fund balance at year end. To complete the purchase, these funds need to be re-appropriated from the Fleet Internal Service Fund (ISF) to the Fleet ISF operating budget for FY 2018-19; and

Big Valley Ford of Stockton, CA, submitted the lowest responsive bid in the amount of \$776,869.85, and its bid is regular in all respects; now, therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the purchase of 23 Police Interceptor Utility Vehicles from Big Valley Ford of Stockton, CA, in the amount of \$776,869.85.

2. The City Council approves the appropriation of funds in the amount of \$776,869.85 from the Fleet ISF (501-0000-101.00-00) to the Fleet ISF FY 2018-19 operating account (501-5060-670-80.02).

3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
