- 1. Pursuant to Section 16.220.040 of the Stockton Municipal Code, the City Council hereby approves the appointment of Anthony Corradi, Thomas Groom, Robert Holzer, and Lourdes Jaurigue to the CHB to serve three-year terms that will expire on October 31, 2021.
- 2. Pursuant to Section 16.220.040 of the Stockton Municipal Code, the City Council hereby approves the appointment of Phillip Merlo, Dale Nichols, Wesley Swanson, Melanie Vieux, and Douglas Vigil to the CHB to serve four-year terms that will expire on October 16, 2022.
- 3. The City Manager is authorized to take any and all necessary and appropriate actions to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
