APPROVE RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A BROWNFIELDS COALITION COMMUNITY-WIDE ASSESSMENT GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY, AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2018-19 ANNUAL BUDGET

The City of Stockton (City) is interested in participating in the Brownfields Assessment and Cleanup Program, which is administered by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to support Brownfields assessment and cleanup efforts; and

Following the City's submittal of a proposal for the Program, the EPA offered to award \$600,000 for the three-year grant program beginning October 1, 2018, and ending September 30, 2021; and

Grant funds will be used for Economic Development Department staff and consultant time related to developing a Brownfield Site Revitalization Program; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Manager or a designated representative is hereby authorized, on behalf of the City, to accept grant funding in the amount of \$600,000 from the EPA.
2. The City Manager or a designated representative is hereby authorized, on behalf of the City, to execute a three-year Memorandum of Agreement (Exhibit 1 attached and incorporated by this reference) between the City of Stockton, Successor Agency to the Former Redevelopment Agency of the City of Stockton, and San Joaquin Council of Governments.
3. The City Manager or a designated representative is hereby authorized and directed, on behalf of the City, to execute the grant documents and to submit all documents, including, without limitation, contracts, amendments, extensions, and payment requests as appropriate to accept the funds under and comply with the conditions of the grant.
