STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA AND APPROPRIATE REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,000,000 FOR THE PURCHASE OF A LAW ENFORCEMENT HELICOPTER

The Stockton-San Joaquin metropolitan area does not currently have access to helicopter air support to assist law enforcement efforts; and

The use of air support, particularly that of a helicopter, can improve police response times, apprehension of fleeing suspects, locating missing persons, reducing vehicle pursuits, increasing police presence and visibility, and respond to natural disasters; and

Assembly Bill 1822 included a provision of \$3,000,000 for the City of Stockton to purchase a helicopter to provide air support to law enforcement and for other purposes; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council hereby accepts a local law enforcement grant allocation of \$3,000,000 from the State of California.
2. The City Council hereby appropriates revenue and expenditure budget in the amount of \$3,000,000 in the Police Department's Fiscal Year 2018-19 Special Grants and Programs Account No. 025-6451.
3. The City Manager is authorized to take such other actions as are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
