RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. CE023-18, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONTRACT CONSTRUCTION FOR THE 2017-18 SANITARY SEWER MAINTENANCE HOLE REHABILITATION, PROJECT NO. M18054

On August 2, 2018, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the 2017-18 Sanitary Sewer Maintenance Hole Rehabilitation (Project No. M18054); and

The project will rehabilitate 29 maintenance holes that are severely deteriorated and are priorities for rehabilitation. The priority locations are part of the large diameter sanitary sewer system located along March Lane, Ryde Avenue, Los Angeles Avenue, and Turnpike Road that are high groundwater table areas with significant infiltration levels; and

SoCal Pacific Construction Corporation dba National Coating and Lining Company's bid in the amount of \$216,228 is regular and responsive in all respects; and

The project is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under the "general rule" at CEQA Guidelines, section 15061(b)(3). The activity does not qualify as a project and/or clearly could not have a significant effect on the environment and, therefore, CEQA does not apply; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the filing of Notice of Exemption No. CE023-18 under CEQA for the 2017-18 Sanitary Sewer Maintenance Hole Rehabilitation (Project No. M18054), a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

2. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the 2017-18 Sanitary Sewer Maintenance Hole Rehabilitation (Project No. M18054).

3. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and SoCal Pacific Construction Corporation dba National Coating and Lining Company, in the amount of \$216,228 and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference. //

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4. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
