APPROVE NEW HIRE STOCKTON PROGRAM TO SUPPORT HIRING AND TRAINING OF LOCAL RESIDENTS FROM ECONOMICALLY DISADVANTAGED AREAS

The City Council adopted the Fiscal Year (FY) 2018-19 Annual Budget on June 5, 2018, following a duly noticed budget study session and a public hearing; and the adopted Annual Budget included \$50,000 from General Funds allocated to Economic Development Department for a workforce incentive program; and

In order to encourage Stockton based businesses to hire, train and retain workforce residing within economically disadvantaged census tracts within Stockton city limits, to provide greater opportunities for disadvantaged communities and improve wages, the City Council of the City of Stockton desires to approve the Hire Stockton Program; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Authorize the Economic Development Department to formally adopt and administer the Hire Stockton Program as outlined in the Program Guidelines incorporated herein as Exhibit 1.
- 2. Authorize the Economic Development Department to enter into contractual grant agreements with eligible awardees and provide grant reimbursements up to \$10,000 under this Program.
- 3. Authorize the City Manager to take necessary and appropriate actions to carry out the purpose and intent of this resolution.
